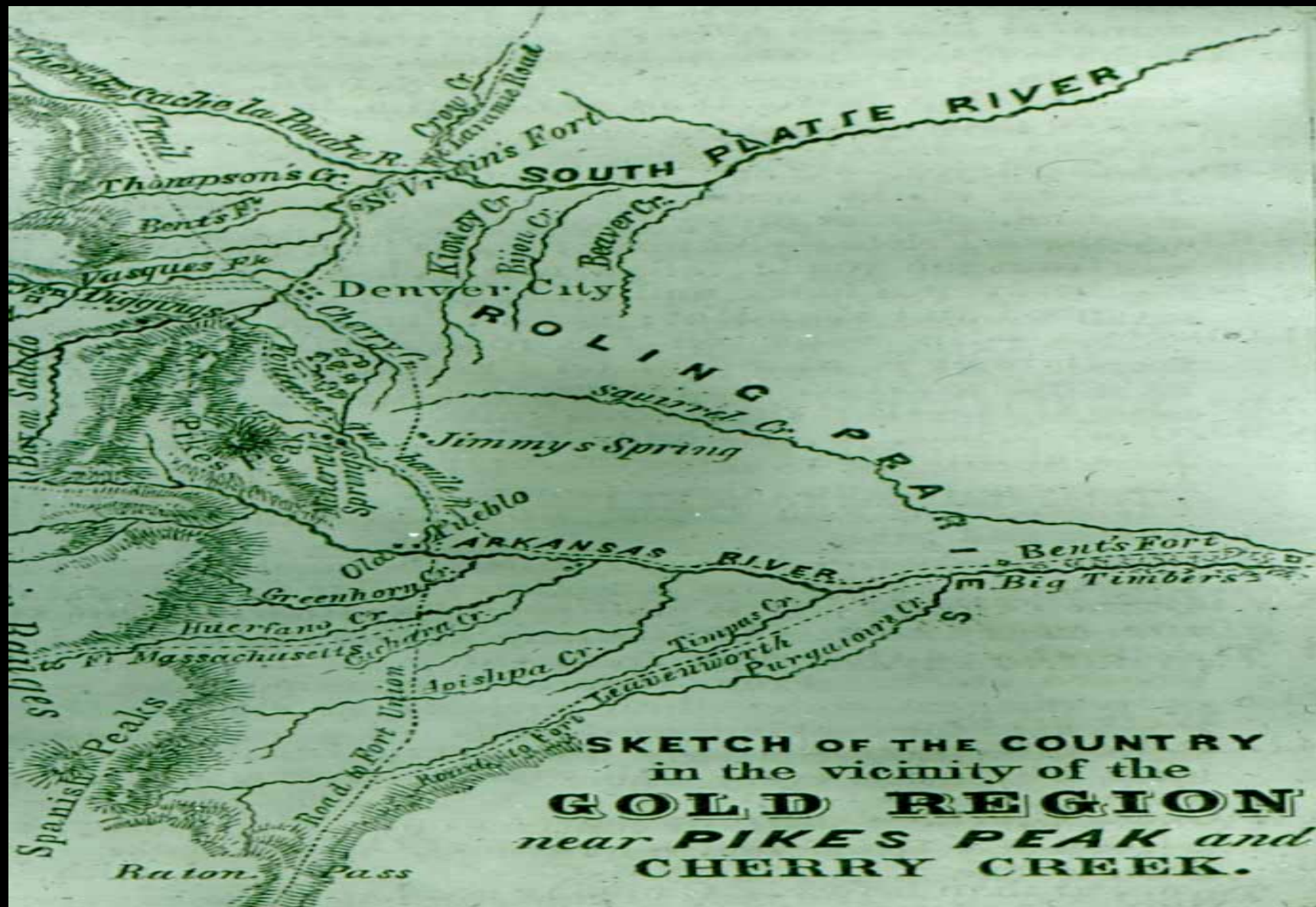
Route of the Exploring Expedition Westward from Council Bluffs

The horse pulls the car to the top of a very steep hill then gets on the front end of the car & rides down.

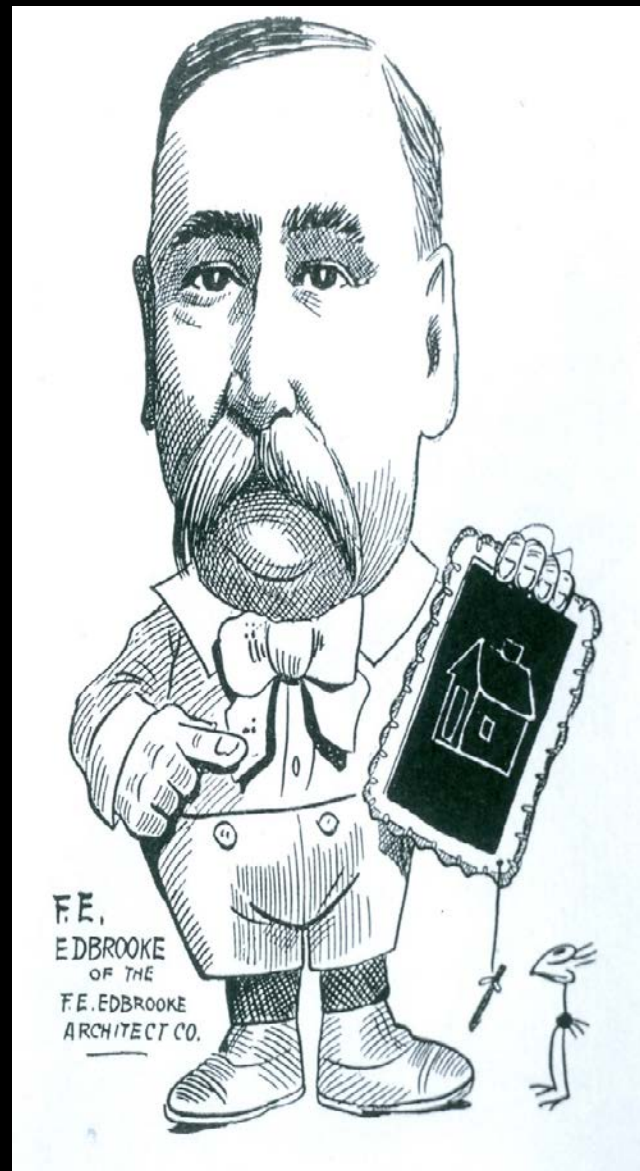

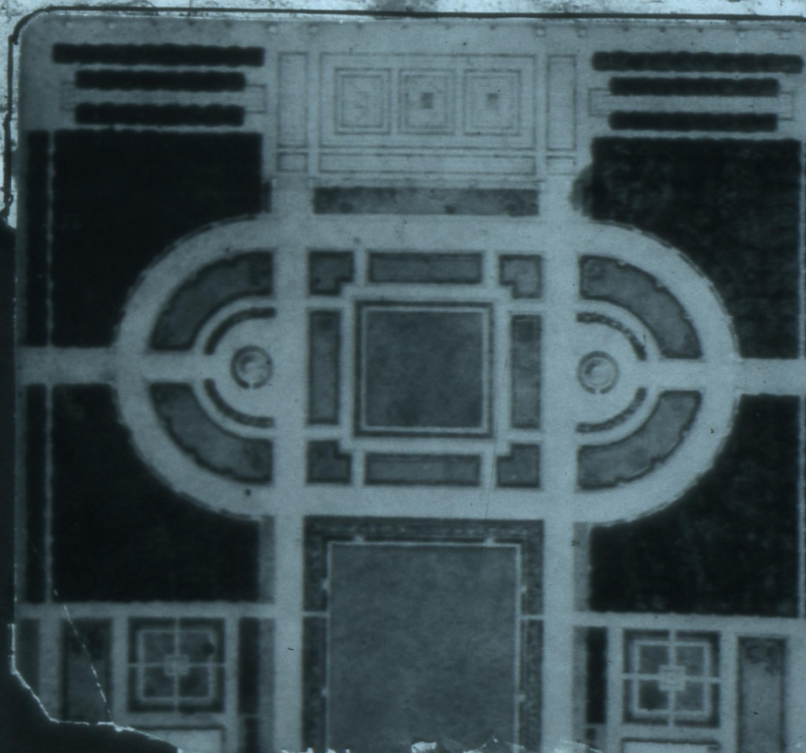

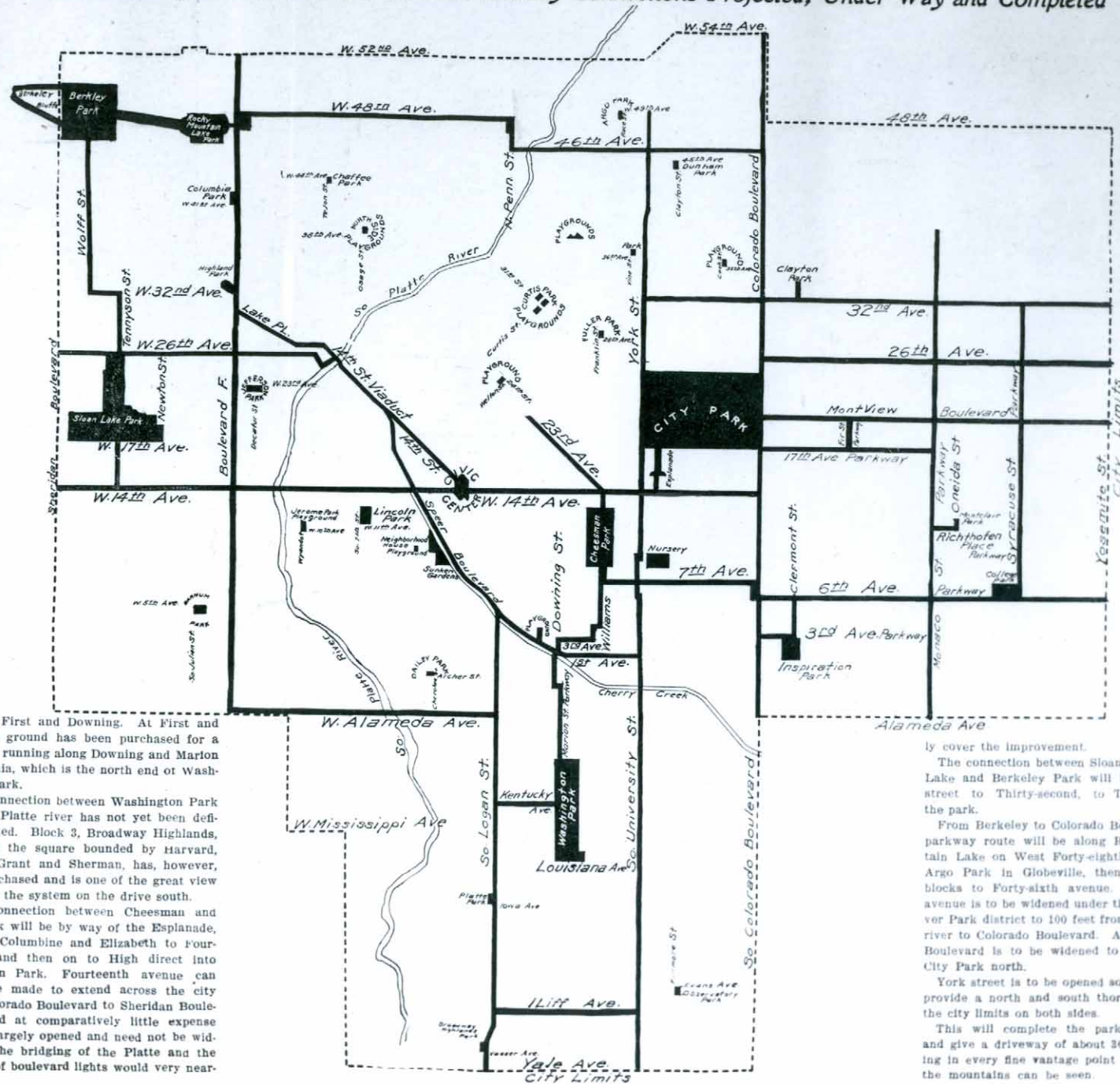

# Plan Showing the Boulevard, Park and Parkway Connections Projected, Under Way and Completed



ward at First and Downing. At First and Downing ground has been purchased for a parkway running along Downing and Marlon to Virginia, which is the north end of Washington Park.

The connection between Washington Park and the Platte river has not yet been definitely fixed. Block 3, Broadway Highlands, which is the square bounded by Harvard, Vassar, Grant and Sherman, has, however, been purchased and is one of the great view points in the system on the drive south.

The connection between Cheesman and City Park will be by way of the Esplanade, through Columbine and Elizabeth to Fourteenth, and then on to High direct into Cheesman Park. Fourteenth avenue can easily be made to extend across the city from Colorado Boulevard to Sheridan Boulevard, and at comparatively little expense as it is largely opened and need not be widened. The bridging of the Platte and the placing of boulevard lights would very near-

ly cover the improvement.

The connection between Sloan and Cooper Lake and Berkeley Park will be on Wolff street to Thirty-second, to Tennyson, to the park.

From Berkeley to Colorado Boulevard the parkway route will be along Rocky Mountain Lake on West Forty-eighth avenue to Argo Park in Globeville, then south two blocks to Forty-sixth avenue. Forty-sixth avenue is to be widened under the East Denver Park district to 100 feet from the Platte river to Colorado Boulevard. And Colorado Boulevard is to be widened to 100 feet to City Park north.

York street is to be opened so that it will provide a north and south thoroughfare to the city limits on both sides.

This will complete the parkway circuit and give a driveway of about 36 miles, taking in every fine vantage point from which the mountains can be seen.
